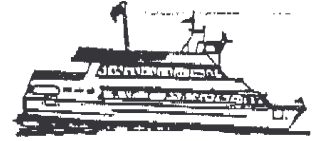


Come and Discover the Thousand Islands

On Friday, 13 June, motor east to Gananoque on the western edge of the Thousand Island Parkway. Accommodation is provided at the Quality Inn and Suites at Gananoque for 2 nights. All meals are included on Saturday, and breakfast is included on Sunday. All meals except Saturday lunch are provided at the Quality Inn and Suites. Also included in this package are a Thousand Island Cruise and a ticket to see The Sunshine Boys at the Springer Theatre. Taxes and gratuities for the meals, accommodation and excursions are included but the cost, taxes, and gratuities for any extra beverages or room charges are your responsibility.

Weekend Rates:

Rates include accommodation for two nights (rooms have two double beds), 2 breakfast buffets, 1 dinner buffet, picnic lunch, a cruise ticket and a theatre ticket.

No theatre tickets or buffet dinner included for children 5 and under. Children 5 and under may order from the children's menu.	

Friday Night

- at your leisure; check in to the hotel and explore the town

Saturday

- Breakfast is at 7:30 a.m. at the hotel.
- At 9:00 a.m. board the boat to cruise the Thousand Islands and pick out your dream cottage.
- Return to shore and explore the Thousand Islands by land
 - drive or cycle the parkway (limited bicycle rental available for the 32 km offroad bicycle path)
 - explore the National Parks display at Mallorytown Landing
- enjoy the hotel heated pool
- supper at the hotel and then a play, at the Springer Theatre.

Sunday

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Free time to explore the area or a chance to call into the historic city of Kingston on the way home

- To get to Gananoque, follow the 401 east of Toronto for approximately 3 hours. Take exit 648 and then take the exit for Hwy 2 immediately on your right. You will find the Parkway Islands Inn on the left-hand side. Telephone: (613) 382-4781.
