

Elmvale Maple Syrup Festival

Meet at the Harris-Tuck farm, 1266 7th Concession of Flos township between 10am and noon. From there, you can enjoy the local events on the main street and the arena.

Area farmers sell produce such as preserves, maple syrup, cheese, sausage and baked goods.

Local artists sell their crafts on the main streets and the arena. Stalls are open from 8:00a.m. to approx. 4:00p.m.

Take the shuttle bus to and from the sugar bush. Take a horse drawn wagon ride and watch how maple syrup is produced.

Pancake Brunch is served with local maple syrup in the Town Hall.

There will be a BBQ dinner at the Harris-Tuck farm between 4pm and 8pm. There will be a small charge to cover the cost of the food. BYOB.
