

# QUEBEC CONFERENCE

**Thursday, February 7,  
2008 to Sunday,  
February 10, 2008.**

Discover Quebec and their education system during Carnival time. The Carnival's origins lie deep within the history of Quebec and this festival is a celebration of winter that has no equal anywhere in the world. Carnaval de Quebec is held in picturesque Quebec City, which was founded in 1608 and is the largest walled city in North America.

Most of the carnival activities take place outside. The normal temperature for Quebec City at this time of year is approximately -15 to -20 degrees Celsius, considerably colder than Toronto or any part of southern Ontario. It is most important to have WARM clothes, especially footwear. Do not attend this event without adequate winter clothing. Bring a bathing suit for the indoor/outdoor swimming pool.

The weekend includes: bus transportation from Toronto; 2 nights accommodation at the Quebec Hilton; one breakfast; an overview of the Quebec education system; a visit to Ste. Anne de Beaupre; a visit to Montmorency Falls and a tour of The Ice Hotel.
