### Conditions of Release

- A) The player named will remain under contract with the YGHC.
- B) The player named is released only on a temporary basis.
- C) The player named must report all injuries occurred while on temporary leave.
- D) This release expires as of May 2007

### YGHC Regulation Three - REGISTRATION

(E) In order to register with a team or organization other than the one with which he has already been registered for the current season, or with which he was registered for the previous season, a player must first obtain a signed YGHC "Player Release" form from his previous team or organization. A player may be released from one organization to another only once during a season, unless special approval from the YGHC Executive Staff. If a player's request for a release is denied, the player may appeal in writing to the YG Executive Staff within 14 days of being denied. Failure to comply with this Regulation will result in possible suspension or for the player in question.
